



## How to use the files and what they do

(This is the technical stuff)

Maybe you already know how to load video and song files onto your iPad.\* If you do, that's awesome. Give yourself one gold star and go outside to play.

If you're not sure about MPEG-4 and MP3 files, that's ok. Read on and all will be revealed.

**The first thing: When you download your files from [Rock Rhythm and Rhyme](#), be sure to download them to your computer, not you iPad.**

The second thing: Establish an iTunes account. It's free. You can get it [here](#).

Next, add the files to your library.

Then, sync your iPad with iTunes and transfer the files to your iPad.

Boom! Done. Kid pleasing songs and videos on your iPad.

(By the way, this also works with PDF files.)

Both the MPEG-4 video files and the MP3 song files will play on your computer or laptop as well. You can use QuickTime. It's free. ☺ You can get it [here](#).

And....you can copy the files onto a cd, DVD or thumb drive if you wish, and play them elsewhere. Maybe the car...?

The worksheets are of course printable and feature big easy to color illustrations and simple instructions. They are great for reinforcing those foundational skills that will be so important in elementary school and beyond.

\*These instructions address apple devices only. As far as I know almost every other tablet on the market allows you to drag and drop files directly from your computer onto your tablet. It's a pretty straight forward process.
